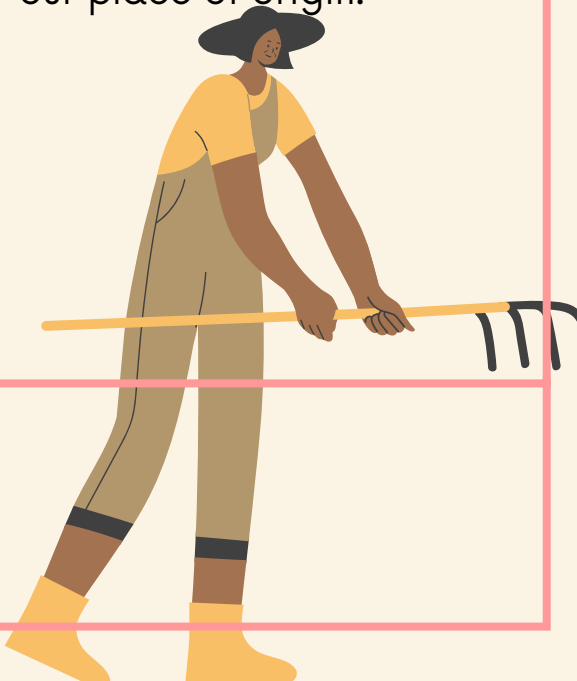
EBRO DELTA

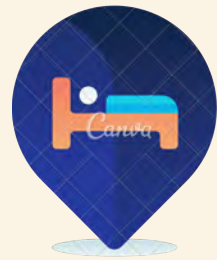

From Deltacleta we will be guided to discover the Fangar Bay and the Illa de Mar green filter.</p>
